Rates in EURO (excluding VAT and taxes)

Procedures & documents

Shipment Processing Procedure to the United Kingdom

1. Formal Requirements

- **Authorization for the Customs Agency** - the client is required to independently send the original authorization (indirect and direct) to the Customs Agency.
- **Registration time** - the authorization registration process at the Customs Office usually takes approximately 3 business days.
- **Identification data** - EORI PL and UK VAT numbers are required for customs clearance.

Value limit - Shipment of goods up to £135 (GBP) in one parcel to one consignee is allowed.

2. Shipment preparation in the SP Panel

For each parcel the client must complete detailed data:

3. Schedule and logistics

- **Shipping days** - transport manifests are created on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays.
- **The manifest** includes parcels physically handed over to SPX before its generation.
- **Logistics handling:**

4. Customs clearance and documentation

Based on panel data, a collective customs invoice (Customs Invoice) is generated for each client.

Important:

This document is used only for export clearance in Poland and import clearance in the UK and is not an accounting document.

After completion the client receives:

From Poland:

- EX document
- XML file from export clearance

From the United Kingdom:

- CDS import document after UK clearance

5. Delivery

After successful import in the UK, parcels are handed over to the local operator, who performs delivery directly to the final recipient.

Price list and costs

Additional costs

1. Customs clearance - HS items

HS code handling fee: €1.5/HS code
Charged for each unique tariff code declared in the shipment.

2. Export declaration

Export declaration (consolidated clearance): €30 / client / transport
One-time fee charged per client transport, regardless of the number of shipments that day.

3. Commodity lines (customs lines)

Customs line - product diversity: €0.20 / line

One line means one unique product (SKU) assigned to the final consignee in a given parcel.
The cost depends on the number of different products in the shipment.

Surcharges

1. Out-of-Gauge surcharges

SMALL	up to 3 kg	19 x 25 x 40 cm	19 000 cm ³
MEDIUM	up to 15 kg	41 x 38 x 64 cm	99 700 cm ³
LARGE	up to 30 kg	length up to 120 cm	160 000 cm ³

- Small → within Medium : **€ 2.90**
- Medium → within Large : **€ 5.22**
- Large → up to 170 cm / 30 kg / 0.16 m³ : **€ 29.00**
- above 170 cm / 30 kg / 0.16 m³ : **€ 87.00**
- Out of Home (locker/store) limit exceeded : **€ 2.90**

2. Other Surcharges

- Out of Area : **€ 6.67**
- ULEZ / Clean Air Zone : **€ 0.08**
- Non-Machinable : **€ 3.07**
- Prohibited or restricted goods not pre-approved for carriage : **€ 29.00**
- Repack : **€ 2.90**
- Relabel : **€ 1.46**
- Missing or incorrect pre-advice data, including recipient email or phone number : **€ 1.55**
- Peak surcharge (applies from the 2nd Monday of November to the 2nd Saturday of January) : **€ 0.12**

IMPORTANT!

As of 1 July 2026, a valid email address and mobile phone number for the recipient are required for every shipment that may be redirected to a locker or collection point. Failure to provide this information will result in an additional charge of € 1.55 per shipment.
